The Project Challenge


With the increased demand in ecommerce and need for facility optimization at their new 1 million sq. ft. distribution hub, Ariat searched for ways to automate their warehouse throughput, productivity, and reduce physical strain for associates.

Our Solution

Geek+ worked together with its strategic partner, Körber Supply Chain Solutions, to deploy 88 shelf-to-person picking robots and 2,000 racks in Ariat's new distribution hub. After their initial order, Ariat expanded the solution with an additional 30 picking robots. Since then, Ariat has experienced a significant increase in picking efficiency and warehouse productivity.
