Hachette originally had two distribution centers about 200 miles apart. Each of the two centers delivered products from its own group of publishers. Stock did not overlap, but both installations served the same customer base. Consolidation and automation was necessary to pave the way for future growth.

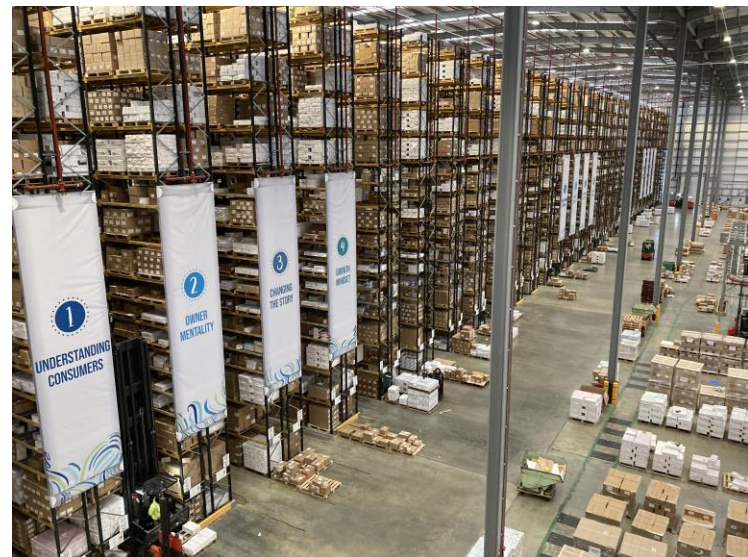
Solution
