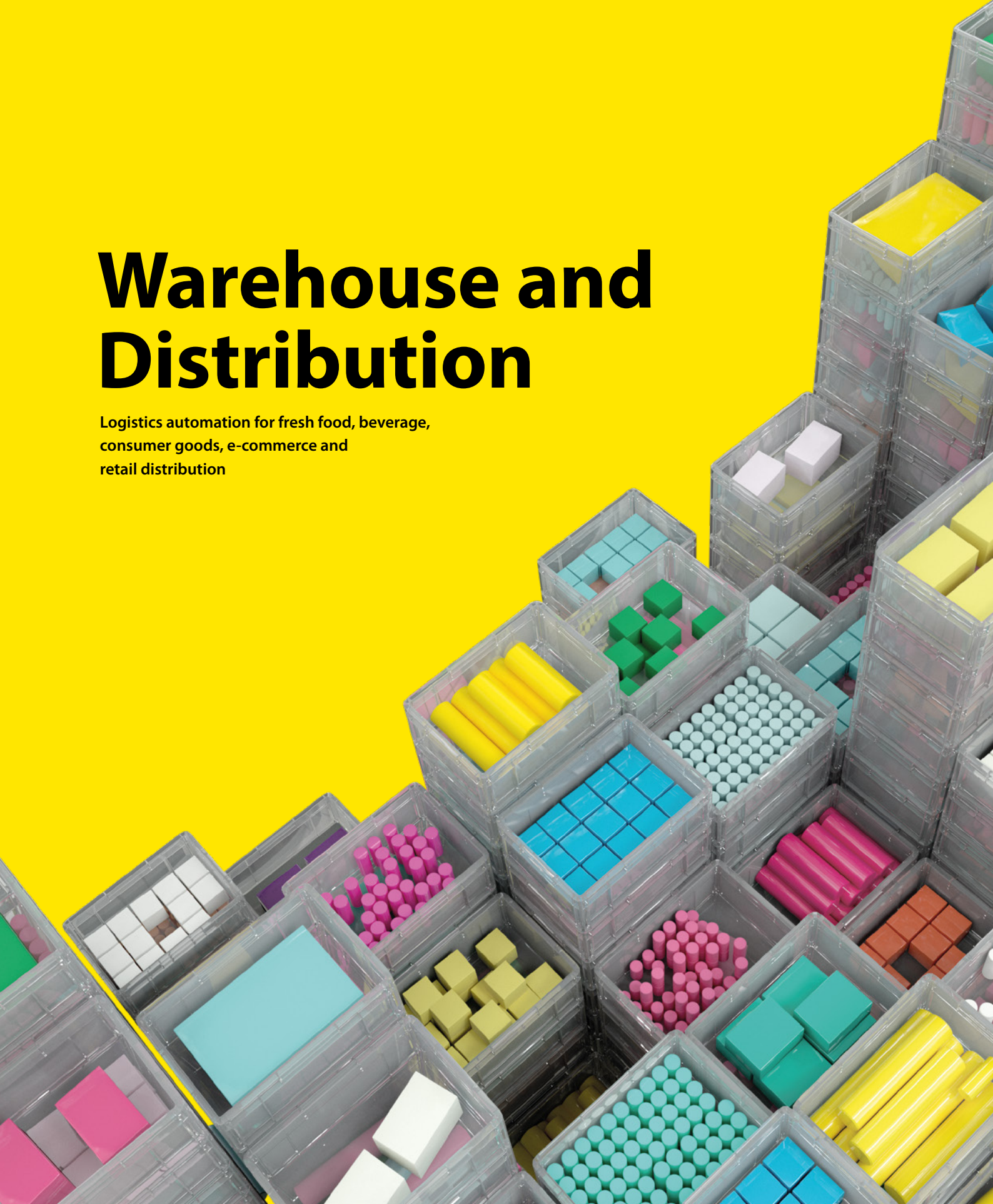

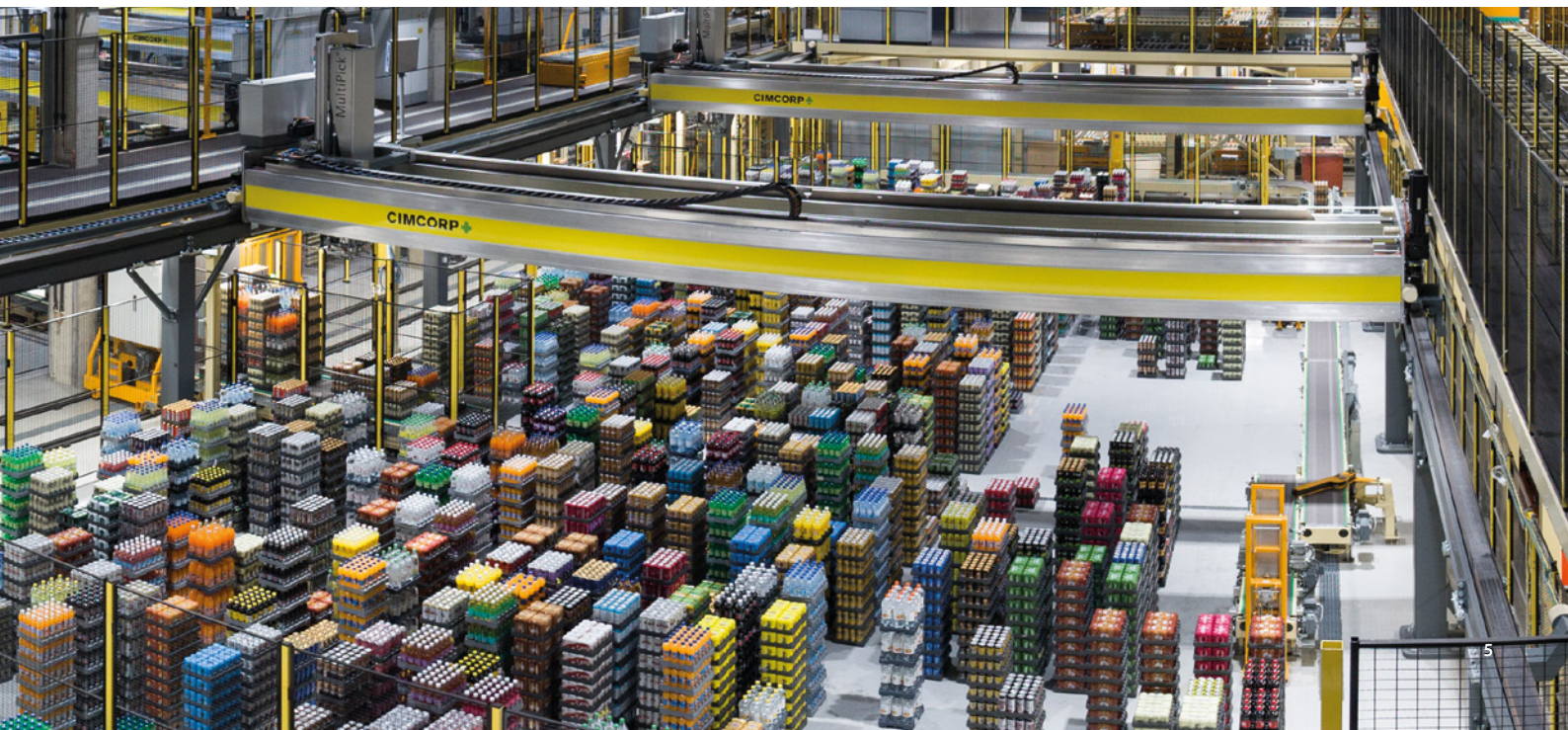
Layers picked in any sequence

Cimcorp's Layer Pick solution combines large, fast robots with a versatile picking tool for the efficient picking of corrugated cases. Designed with the consumer goods and food and beverage markets in mind, this solution has built-in flexibility to move virtually any boxed product on the market.

By integrating an automated robotic layer picking system, manufacturers, distributors and supply chain professionals can employ just-in-time order picking, increase efficiency, reduce labor costs, eliminate errors and ensure traceability as products move throughout the facility.


