TYPE OF INSPECTION	FREQUENCY	OSHA REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION
Initial Inspection	Prior to use of New or Altered Cranes	Record of Inspection
Pre-Shift Functional Test	Beginning of Each Shift	Record of Function Test Recommended
Frequent Inspection	Required Monthly or at defined intervals	Record of Inspection
Periodic Inspection	Annually to Quarterly (based on duty cycle)	Record of Inspection
Not in Regular Use	Idle for 1 month+ but < 6 Months	Record of Inspection
Preventative Maintenance	Based on OEM Recommendation	Record of PM
Repairs and Adjustments	Existence of Unsafe Conditions	Record of Repair
